Reading

<u>History</u>

Bronze Age

We will understand what Britain looked like during the bronze age.

Think about how people survived during the bronze age.

Look at the different tools that were used.

Understand what roles people had within their culture and learn about their settlements.

Geography

We will be focussing on the following;

Understanding the globe.

Looking at physical and human features around the world.
Focussing on the non-European country of Mexico.
Understanding the location and climate of Mexico.
Looking at the physical features of Mexico—mountains, land use and forests.

Looking at the human features of Mexico.

RE

Jesus

The aim of this unit is to deepen the children's insight into the impact Jesus had/has on people's lives. We will be focussing on the values - Forgiveness, Humility, and Service.

Easter

Is the cross a symbol of sadness or joy?

Children will understand the Easter story, exploring the feelings evoked then and now. Children will discuss how the Church services reflect sadness and joy.

Science

Animals including plants and humans

- What type of nutrition do we need? Eatwell plate.
 - How does our skeleton help us?
 - Do our bones affect what we can do?
 - What do our muscles do?
 - Do all animals have the same skeleton?

Computing Touch Typing

Children will develop the ability to touch type the home, bottom and top rows.

Emails and Branching Databases

Children will think about ways of communication and learn to compose an email. They will learn how to use email safely. When using branching databases children will learn to sort objects and learn how complete a branching database using 2Question on Purple Mash.

Music

We will be following the Lancashire Music Service Scheme of Work.

We will be exploring simple patterns and notation within different pieces of music and composition.



PE

A variety of games, fundamental skills—hopping, skipping, catching and throwing, dance and gymnastics. The children will be having exciting PE sessions with 'Team Theme' every Wednesday.

Art and DT

The first half of the term we will be concentrating on our painting skills. We will be using a variety of techniques and different brush sizes and mixing primary colours to create different tones. During the second half term we will be creating wire structures.
